

Marleigh oats

Overview

Marleigh is an exciting, mid-late maturity, improved grazing oat, with outstanding early vigour, fast biomass production and recovery post grazing. Marleigh comes out of South American breeding program and is our best oat for winter grazing.

Marleigh shines at filling the autumn/winter feed gap and provides a large quantity of high quality biomass early in the season. Marleigh then has the ability to recover and regrow for further grazing opportunities.

Winter Feed Gap Trials

The photos show Marleigh grown in AGF Seeds Winter Feed Gap trial sown April 5th in Smeaton, Victoria. The images taken on June 14th show Marleigh's outstanding early vigour even in cool environments as it out paced other common winter cereals in the trial and proved its potential to produce large amounts of biomass very quickly. The bottom right image is taken from ground level on the side further demonstrating Marleigh's ability to outperform other winter cereals with its early biomass production.
